- Collect a wide range of sizes of diapers (sizes newborn-size 6 and pullups).
- Include baby wipes in your diaper drive.
- Set goals to help keep your diaper drive on track.
- Remember to spread the word about your diaper drive including taking advantage of the power of social media.
- Establish a method for collecting and delivering the diapers.
